Her long cherished dream of a home was materialised by your intervention with the generous contribution of your parishioners and other benefactors.

The hearts of the family members of Ms. Rosamma is overwhelmed **by the blessings of the Almighty on them during this Christmas in the form of a new home**. The house was blessed in a very small function. And we are grateful to you **Very Rev. Fr. Waldemar Obrebski, Fr. Rejimon Francis CST and Parishners of St. Joseph, the Worker church Senden**, for your concern towards the poor and your courage to live our Charism *“Be little and Serve the Little*.
